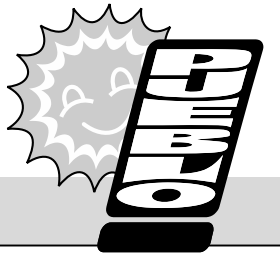

10-Year Report on Colorado Children— KIDS' PROGRAMS SHRIVEL AS POVERTY DOUBLES

ColChldCam 12/13—A report released Monday by the Colorado Children's Campaign shows that Colorado's investment in children's programs and services was minimal to moderate over the last 10 years, despite a growing child population and childhood poverty rate during that same time, and that the purchasing power of money invested in children's programs and services steadily declined since 2000.

The Colorado Children's Budget 2010, intended to be resource guide for policymakers and advocates to better understand Colorado's investments in kids, provides 10 years of appropriation information and analysis on investment trends in four areas: early childhood development, K-12 education, health care and family supports.

According to an analysis by the Colorado Legislative Council staff, from FY 1999-00 to FY 2008-09, Colorado's tax collections dropped 25.8 percent. During this same time, the number of children in Colorado under 18 years of age increased 12 percent and the number of children living in poverty increased 102 percent.

"While revenue and resources were shrinking, numbers of children and rates of poverty were growing," said Chris Watney, President of the Colorado

Children's Campaign. "As Colorado families and children continue to struggle with the recession, decision makers struggle to invest increasingly limited funds to support them. This report is intended to provide the kind of data and analysis that can help us all better understand the landscape and navigate the tough choices about how to support our most vulnerable population."

Other key findings from the report include:

- While programs and services for children are intended to work in concert, they tend to have very different federal, state and local rules, regulations and obligations, making it difficult to align programs and services and maximize the benefits for kids.

- Often, whether or not a program experienced growth over the last decade hinged on one of three factors: (1) state constitutional protections; (2) dedicated cash fund revenue; or (3) ability to leverage substantial federal funding in lieu of or in addition to block grants, making it critically important for policymakers and child advocates to consider Colorado's constitutional constraints on the state budget, as well as dedicated state funding sources and federal funding for programs

Adults in contact with infants should get pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine

ColHealth 12/16—With holiday gatherings of family and friends just around the corner, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment is recommending that adults who will have contact with infants, give those kids the gift of protection by having themselves vaccinated against pertussis. Colorado is among several states that have seen a notable increase in the number of pertussis (whooping cough) cases reported this year.

The state health department recommends people who are caring for an infant or are a member of a household with an infant, should be vaccinated. This includes

—all adult infant care providers including adults age 65 and older;

—under-immunized preadolescents (ages 7-10 years).

People should contact their pharmacy, health care provider's office or local public health agency for vaccinations.

Joni Reynolds, director the state's immunization program at CDPHE, said, "Pertussis is a highly contagious disease, making unimmunized or incompletely immunized infants particularly vulnerable. By vaccinating family members and those who live or work around these young children, we better protect infants and young children."

Reynolds explained that pertussis affects the airways and may be milder in adolescents and adults, especially those who have been vaccinated. However, pertussis can cause severe illness especially in young infants, and in rare cases can be fatal. Babies cannot begin the first of the three recommended pertussis infant vaccinations until they are at least 6 weeks old, which is why it is important for adults who are caring for infants to be vaccinated.

Circle of Protection...

To combat pertussis, commonly known as whooping cough, the department developed the *Colorado Circle of Protection* program which began as a pilot project in Douglas County in October 2009. The program's goal is to increase Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) vaccinations among health care workers, parents of newborns and family members, or others who have close contact with in-

fants and young children. The "circle of protection" is especially needed for children 6 months of age and younger since they cannot be vaccinated against pertussis.

Zogby: Most voters approve of Obama-GOP deal on tax cuts, extension of jobless benefits

Zogby 12/15—The deal including tax cuts and extended unemployment benefits struck last week by President Barack Obama and Congressional Republicans is approved by 61% of likely voters.

The same poll also found that just over half of respondents believe it is hypocritical for politicians to say they are concerned about the budget deficit, and still support either cutting taxes for the wealthy (55%) or extending jobless benefits (52%).

As would be expected, significant differences arise on these issues between Democrats and Republicans which are demonstrated in the following query results:

Question: Do you approve or disapprove of the agreement between President Obama and Congressional Republicans that includes: retaining tax cuts for all income levels, including those above \$250,000; a temporary payroll tax cut, and the continuation of tax breaks for parents and students?

New data shows third consecutive quarterly decline in negative R.E. equity

CoreLogic 12/13—CoreLogic, a leading provider of information, analytics and business services, today released negative equity data indicating a third consecutive quarterly decline in negative equity for residential properties. CoreLogic reports that 10.8 million, or 22.5 percent, of all residential properties with mortgages were in negative equity at the end of the third quarter of 2010, down from 11.0 million and 23 percent in the second quarter. This is due primarily to foreclosures of severely negative equity properties rather than an increase in home values.

During this year the number of borrowers in negative equity has declined by over 500,000 borrowers. An additional 2.4 million borrowers had less than five percent equity in the third quarter. Together, negative equity and near-negative equity mortgages accounted for 27.5 percent of all residential properties with a mortgage nationwide. Negative equity, often referred to as "underwater" or "upside down," means that borrowers owe more on their mortgages than their homes are worth. Negative equity can occur because of a decline in value, an increase in mortgage debt or a combination of both.

Data Highlights

Negative equity remains concentrated in five states: Nevada, which had the highest negative equity

percentage with 67 percent of all of its mortgaged properties underwater, followed by Arizona (49 percent), Florida (46 percent), Michigan (38 percent) and California (32 percent).

The largest declines in negative equity were concentrated in the hardest hit states. Alaska experienced the largest decline, falling 1.8 percentage points, followed by Nevada (-1.6), Arizona (-1.4), California (-1.2), and Florida (-0.9). Idaho and Alabama are the only states with noticeable increases, which is not a surprise given they are currently the two top states for home price depreciation.

Although the level of negative equity is very high, there are still many homeowners with equity (Figure 4). Nearly half of New York borrowers have 50 percent or more positive equity, which leads the nation, followed by Hawaii (43 percent), Massachusetts (40 percent), Connecticut (39 percent) and Rhode Island (40 percent). There are some states that have barbell distributions of somewhat higher negative equity shares and higher percentages of borrowers with 50 percent or more positive equity. Rhode Island is the most extreme example as it ranks in the top 15 for both negative equity and for states with the highest share of 50 percent or more positive equity. To a lesser de-

BIRDERS PREP FOR ANNUAL HOLIDAY COUNTS

ColWildlifeDiv 12/13—Colorado children are not the only ones looking forward to the holiday season. Birders across the state are gearing up for two of the high points of the birding year, the Christmas Bird Count and the Midwinter Waterfowl Survey. Thousands of people across the Western Hemisphere participate in the annual Christmas Bird Count, a grassroots effort to tally bird species from Canada to South America that traces its origins back over 100 years. Colorado birders are no exception. From December 14 through January 5, volunteers will take to the field with binoculars and notebooks as they track bird populations around the state in one of the longest-running citizen science projects in United States history. "The Christmas Bird Count is a great way for citizens interested in wildlife management to get involved," said DOW Bird Conservation Coordinator David Klute. "It is one of the few widespread counts we've got that looks at wintering birds." Hundreds of volunteers will flock to designated "count circles" around Colorado to help document bird species and population numbers. According to the Audubon Society, more than 50,000 observers across the country participate in the bird census each winter. "The Christmas Bird Count is the highlight of the year for many of Colorado's birders because it's a chance to get together with old friends and directly witness changes in bird numbers and patterns from year to year in a favorite birding area," said Ken Strom, Director of Audubon Colorado. "It's a rite of winter that brings with it the exciting possibility of seeing a bird species that you've never encountered before at this time of year." During the first week in January, wildlife agencies in the lower 48 states, in collaboration with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, conduct the annual Midwinter Waterfowl Count. DOW biologists and volunteers will

count ducks, geese and swans around the state as part of this survey. Both of the annual bird counts gather data that state and federal biologists use to determine the prevalence and well-being of the nation's bird populations. Such information is an invaluable tool for ornithologists, biologists and others tracking bird populations. "We know that some birds are declining," said DOW researcher Jim Gammonley. "If we can identify those population trends over the long run, we can be proactive and take action ahead of time." The first Christmas Bird Count was done on Christmas Day of 1900 as an alternative activity to an event called the "side hunt," when people would choose sides and go afield with their guns. Whichever team brought in the most game - whether feathered or furred - won. The tradition changed when the national association of the Audubon Society proposed to count birds on Christmas Day rather than shoot them. The Christmas Bird Count still provided excitement and allowed for friendly competition, and the tallies made every year since then continue to make a difference for science and bird conservation. The Christmas Bird Count is the longest running database in ornithology, representing 111 years of unbroken data on trends of early winter bird populations. The Midwinter Waterfowl Count, which takes place the first week in January, began the late-1940s. It provides an annual snapshot of the continental distribution and abundance of waterfowl after the fall migration period. For some waterfowl populations, the Midwinter Count provides the primary survey data used to set population objectives, measure population size, and guide hunting regulations and other management actions. Gammonley said ground and aerial surveys conducted near major river drainages and around Front Range ponds, lakes, and reservoirs in Colorado can lend insights into

habitat use and the health and migration patterns of bird populations over several decades. For instance, past years' records indicate that by this time of year, most of Colorado's 20-plus duck species have migrated south, with only eight or nine species left by early January. The mallard duck is the most common species that winters in Colorado, Gammonley said. He said numbers of snow geese and Ross' geese wintering in Colorado have increased dramatically over the past three decades. Three populations of Canada geese winter in Colorado: Rocky Mountain Population Canada geese occur west of the Continental Divide, and Hi-Line Population and Shortgrass Prairie Population Canada geese occur east of the Continental Divide. Rocky Mountain and Hi-Line Canada geese also breed in Colorado and surrounding states, and their numbers have increased steadily over the past several decades. Shortgrass Prairie Canada

geese breed in the Canadian Arctic and their numbers fluctuate more over time. "That's why surveys like this are important" said Gammonley. "We're trying to manage our waterfowl hunting opportunities to be consistent with maintaining healthy bird populations," he said. As a bonus, participants take satisfaction in knowing that their observations contribute to biologists' knowledge. "There's the additional reward of knowing that you're participating in an important nationwide effort to document long-term trends in bird distributions and numbers, and that you're contributing your personal observations to a huge body of scientific data that's important to bird conservation in Colorado and beyond," Strom added.
